

ORDINANCE 1991-4
of the
South Lyons Township Sanitary District
Cook County, Illinois

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 1973-6 entitled
"AN ORDINANCE prohibiting the Entry of Extraneous
Flows into the Sanitary Sewer System Through Illegal
Connections from Private Properties."

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the South Lyons Township Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois that Ordinance 1973-6 entitled "An Ordinance Prohibiting the Entry of Extraneous Flows into the Sanitary Sewer System Through Illegal Connections from Private Properties" be amended as follows:

(1) Section 6. Because of their almost instantaneous impact, their injurious results, substantial contributions, and relative ease of correction, the District will institute a priority program for the elimination of extraneous flows entering into the sanitary sewer system through downspouts, roof drains and other visible or outside connections which are connected directly or indirectly to the sanitary sewer system.

The District may, at any time, make visual outside inspections of all properties within the District, with specific attention to downspouts, roof drains and other visible or outside connections, and the District may, at any time, enter into the premises and make or assist in the making of additional inspections of the premises to ascertain if illegal connections are present. Upon completion of the visual outside or inside inspection, the District will advise the property owner in writing if any illegal connections are observed, and will advise on the manner of corrections for compliance with the provisions of this Ordinance. After the corrections are made, the District may make further inspections of the corrections to insure compliance with this Ordinance.

(2) Section 7. Within thirty (30) days after the notice to the property owner by the District of the presence of illegal connections, the property owner shall, at his expense, disconnect all illegal connections observed and all discharges of extraneous flows into the sanitary sewer system, directly or indirectly, shall be discontinued.

(3) Except as is hereby expressly amended, all the provisions of Ordinance 1973-6 as amended shall remain in full force and effect.


(4) The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall not effect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

(5) All ordinances and parts of this Ordinance not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.


