AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 1989-1 entitled,
"An Ordinance setting forth procedures for
disconnecting sewer connections to the sewer system
of the South Lyons Township Sanitary District
for delinquent bills, and notice and request for hearing."

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the South Lyons Township Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois that Ordinance 1989-1 entitled, "An Ordinance setting forth procedures for disconnecting sewer connections to the sewer system of the South Lyons Township Sanitary District for delinquent bills, and notice and request for hearing" be amended as follows:

(1) Section 3. Notice and Request for Hearing. Before said sewer connection shall be disconnected, notice shall be served upon the user either by certified mail or in person informing said user of the sixty (60) day delinquency, the amount due, plus penalties, and the date on which service will be shut off.

(2) Section 4. Form of Notice. The form of the notice shall be as follows:

(3) Any Ordinance or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

(4) The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall not effect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

(5) All Ordinance and parts of this Ordinance not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

(6) That this Ordinance after its passage and approval shall be in full force and take effect after its publication as provided by law.


