

ORDINANCE 1992-2

OF THE

SOUTH LYONS TOWNSHIP SANITARY DISTRICT
COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

An ordinance amending Ordinance 1989-7 entitled "An Ordinance regulating the use of public and private sewers and drains, the installation and connection of building sewers, the discharge of waters and wastes into the public sewer system, and providing penalties for violation thereof; the establishment of permit fees," and as heretofore amended by Ordinance No. 1990-5.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the South Lyons Township Sanitary District, Cook County Illinois that Ordinance 1989-7 entitled 'An Ordinance regulating the use of public and private sewers and drains, the installation and connection of building sewers, the discharge of waters and wastes into the public sewer system, and providing penalties for violation thereof; the establishment of permit fees" as heretofore amended by Ordinance No. 1990-5, be further amended as follows:

Section One

ARTICLE II

Sec. 3

in the matter of connecting fees, a single family property, townhouse or townhouse condominium pays \$600.00 per connection, regardless of lot size. In the case of commercial or industrial use, the fee is \$750.00 for each 1/2 acre or any part hereof. In the case of multi-unit residential apartment or condominium buildings, each separate building pays the following fees per connection:

2 to 5 unit building	\$750.00 per building
6 to 12 unit building	\$150.00 per unit
13 to 36 unit building	\$100.00 per unit
37 or more unit building	\$75.00 per unit

Section Two

Except as hereby expressly amended, all the provisions of Ordinance 1989-7 as amended shall remain in full force and effect.

Section Three

The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of the Ordinance shall not effect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Section Four


All ordinance and parts of ordinances not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

This ordinance shall be effective after its passage and approval and take effect after its publication as provided by law.




