

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-9
of the
SOUTH LYONS TOWNSHIP SANITARY DISTRICT
(formerly operating as the Countryside Sanitary District)

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR ALL CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE SOUTH LYONS TOWNSHIP SANITARY DISTRICT, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1ST DAY OF JUNE, 2000, AND ENDING ON THE 31ST DAY OF MAY, 2001.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the South Lyons Township Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois:

SECTION 1: That the amount hereinafter set forth, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, and the same are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the sanitary district as that property is assessed and equalized for the current year, and for such purposes as: General Corporate, General Insurance, Liability Insurance, Unemployment Insurance, Worker's Compensation and Social Security for the South Lyons Township Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois, for the fiscal year commencing the 1st day of June, 2000 and ending on the 31st day of May, 2001.

SECTION 2. That amount levied for each object and purpose is placed in a separate column under the heading "Amount to be Raised by Tax Levy" which appears over same being as follows, to wit:

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.



NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE FOR THE VILLAGE OF LA GRANGE

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for the Village of La Grange for the 2000 levy year will be held on December 4, 2000, at 7:30 p.m. at the Village Hall.

Any person desiring to appear at the public hearing and present testimony to the taxing district may contact Ms. Marlies Perthel, Village Manager, 53 S. La Grange Road, La Grange, IL 60525 at (708) 579-2318.

- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes to be extended or abated for the 1999 levy year were \$4,757,089.

The proposed corporate and special purpose taxes to be levied for the 2000 levy year are \$4,983,847. This represents a 4.77 percent increase over the previous year.

- III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for the 1999 levy year were \$332,588.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service (includes bonds) and public building commission leases for the 2000 levy year are \$304,500. This represents an 8.45 percent decrease over the previous year.

- IV. The total property taxes extended for the 1999 levy year were \$5,089,677.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for the 2000 levy year are \$5,288,347. This represents a 3.90 percent increase over the previous year.
