

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-3

(formerly operating as the Countryside Sanitary District)

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR ALL CORPORATE PURPOSES
FOR THE SOUTH LYONS TOWNSHIP SANITARY DISTRICT, COOK
COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1ST
DAY OF JUNE, 2002, AND ENDING ON THE 31ST DAY OF MAY, 2003.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the South Lyons Township Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois:

SECTION 1: That the amount hereinafter set forth, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, and the same are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the sanitary district as that property is assessed and equalized for the current year, and for such purposes as: General Corporate, General Insurance, Liability Insurance, Unemployment Insurance, Worker's Compensation and Social Security for the South Lyons Township Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois, for the fiscal year commencing the 1st day of June, 2002 and ending on the 31st day of May, 2003.

SECTION 2. That amount levied for each object and purpose is placed in a separate column under the heading "Amount to be Raised by Tax Levy" which appears over same being as follows, to wit:

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.


