

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-4  
of the  
SOUTH LYONS TOWNSHIP SANITARY DISTRICT  
(formerly operating as the Countryside Sanitary District)

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR ALL CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE SOUTH LYONS TOWNSHIP SANITARY DISTRICT, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1ST DAY OF JUNE, 2004, AND ENDING ON THE 31ST DAY OF MAY, 2005.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the South Lyons Township Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois:

**SECTION 1:** That the amount hereinafter set forth, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, and the same are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the sanitary district as that property is assessed and equalized for the current year, and for such purposes as: General Corporate, General Insurance, Liability Insurance, Unemployment Insurance, Worker's Compensation and Social Security for the South Lyons Township Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois, for the fiscal year commencing the 1st day of June, 2004 and ending on the 31st day of May, 2005.

**SECTION 2.** That amount levied for each object and purpose is placed in a separate column under the heading "Amount to be Raised by Tax Levy" which appears over same being as follows, to wit:

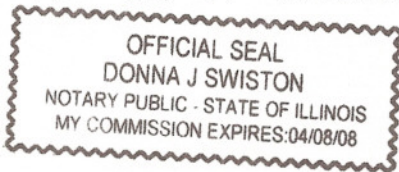

**Notice of Proposed Property Tax Levy for the  
South Lyons Township Sanitary District**

A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy for the South Lyons Township Sanitary District for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2004 and ending May 31, 2005 will be held on Thursday, December 16, 2004 at 6:00 p.m. at the sanitary district offices, 6246 Joliet Road, Suite 1, Countryside, Illinois.

- I. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for the fiscal year that ended May 31, 2004 were \$222,934

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2004 and ending May 31, 2005 are \$222,942. No appreciable increase or decrease.

- II. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for the fiscal year ending May 31, 2004 were zero.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2004 are zero. This represents no change from the previous year.

- III. The total property taxes extended or abated for the fiscal year ending May 31, 2004 were \$222,934.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2004 are \$222,942. This represents no appreciable increase or decrease from the previous year.

Any notice which includes any information not specified and required by this Article shall be an invalid notice. All hearings shall be open to the public.

The corporate authority of the taxing district must explain the reasons for the proposed levy and shall permit persons desiring to be heard an opportunity to present testimony within reasonable time limits as the authority determines.
