

**Ordinance 2005-2
Of the
South Lyons Township Sanitary District
Cook County, Illinois**

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 1996-4 entitled "An Ordinance regulating the use of public and private sewers and drains, the establishment of permitting procedures and fee collection on the installation and connection of building sewers, the discharge of waters and wastes into the public sewer system, and the provision for penalties for violation of requirements."

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the South Lyons Township Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois, that Ordinance 1996-4 be amended as follows:

Section 1.

APPENDIX B: Sewer Permit Documents

The following permit forms and conditions are hereby attached to this ordinance.

SF-300 Sewer Permit General Conditions

13. The permittee as applicant, is responsible for paying all fees and expenses incurred in obtaining the permit for the construction of the proposed facilities, including such fees that may be assessed by agencies other than the South Lyons Township Sanitary District. In addition to permit fees, the District requires the sewer contractor performing the permitted work to post a \$10,000 permit bond. The permit bond must run in favor of the District and be in effect for a period of one year, or the duration of the project which ever is greater. The permit fee is subject to review and change as approved by the Board of Trustees of the District. The Current fee schedule is as follows:

PERMIT CATEGORY	RESIDENTIAL PROJECT	COMMERCIAL PROJECT
Sewer Repair Permit: 0' - 25' *	\$100.00	\$1,000.00
Sewer Repair Permit: 25' + **	\$250.00	\$2,500.00
Sewer Construction Permit: Main Extension	\$5,000.00	\$5,000.00
Disconnection/Reconnection Permit (Lateral Connection)	\$1,100.00	\$5,100.00

(*) Sewer Lateral Revision includes repair, modification, or replacement lengths greater than twenty-five feet, the installation of manholes, and the installation of grease basins.

Section 2. Except as is hereby expressly amended, all the provisions of Ordinance 1996-4 as amended shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3

The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Section 4

All ordinances and parts of ordinances not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5

This Ordinance shall be effective after its passage and approval and shall be in force and take effect immediately after its publication as provided by law.


